Day 1


Basic Design Philosophy:

An IQ20 unit is dismantled to show electrical, electronic and mechanical modular construction and interchangeability.

Actuator Re-build: Attendees to re build unit.



Day 2

IQ Range commissioning – using an actuated valve.

Basic Setting: - Password protection, Direction, Torque and Limit settings to suit all valve types. **Secondary Settings** - **Standard Features:** Setting of control and indication functions to suit remote control applications.

Secondary Settings – Optional Features: Setting of Folomatic, Pakscan field unit, Interrupter Timer and Current Position Transmitter as applicable to suit control applications.
